**MINUTES**

1. Meeting was started at 6:08 by President Charles Dicks, with 38 people in attendance
2. We were given a police report by officer Johnny García. He mentioned that in total there were 113 cases reported, mostly non violent offenses. There were 28 reports of graffiti during the month.
3. Officer García encouraged all of us to visit the website of the city of Dallas to inform ourselves about code violations and proper avenues to submit reports.
4. Officer Morganfield reported 3 stolen catalytic converters and encouraged us to do our part to stop crime by locking our cars and not leaving stuff unattended. She also praised us for having a safe neighborhood in general.
5. Veronica Torres talked to us about Proposal A that will be on the ballots in the next election. It is a 1.2 billion expansion to the Convention center/Fair park that will be funded by a 2% tourist tax. Dallas residents won't be affected by that increase. If passed, the project has an estimated completion date of 2026. More information will be available on the website for the city of Dallas.
6. People raised the issue of speeding along Cesar Chavez. Officer García said that complaints of this kind and anything else related to transit/streets should be submitted at 311 with as much detail as we can (time of the day, location, vehicles involved if possible). The more people submitting a report about a specific case and the more information the better.
